Plasma Cleaner (in basement)

- 1. Put the grids onto the glass slide into the Petri dish and place it inside the plasma cleaner.
- 2. Turn on the pump, close the "door" and hold it there until it is sucked tight to the opening.
- 3. Tighten the screw on the door until an air pressure of $2,2x \ 10^{-1}$ torr (0.3 mbar) is reached.
- 4. Then, turn on the plasma cleaner and wait until the purple light appears. It is easier to see when the lights are dimmed.
- 5. Glow discharge the grids for 30".
- 6. Turn off the high voltage after the time is over and loosen the screw of the needle valve.
- 7. Only after the pressure is around 30 torr, turn off the pump.
- 8. Take out your grids. You may use them within a time of 30 min.
